Major  
Milestones:

1934 – The credit union was chartered May 25, 1934 to serve state employees. The credit union started with about 22 members each depositing a five-dollar share.

1963 – Became one of the first credit unions to offer mortgage loans to members.

1978 - CSECU obtained deposit insurance from the National Credit Union Administration (NCUA), which insures deposits up to \$250,000.

1984 - Share draft accounts (checking accounts) were first offered by CSECU, marking the beginning of its role as a full service financial institution.

1989 - The field of membership for CSECU was expanded to include employees, appointees, and officials of Colorado counties, school districts, municipalities, and special districts that do not have a state chartered credit union serving their needs.

2007 - Name change from Colorado State Employees Credit Union to Credit Union of Colorado (August 31).

2012 - Assets reach and surpass the \$1 billion level

2013 – Ground broken on new Cañon City branch building

2014 - New Cañon City branch building opens on 7/14/14

2017 – Ten-year milestone since name change 8/31/07; assets grew from \$715 million to \$1.44 billion
